1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

• Project Need:

CEF's aim to impart education to rural children in the serene rural ambience who cannot otherwise access or afford it. Provision of entrepreneurial, holistic approach, vocational, child-centered education is our object.

Further, it is our motto that financial constraints should not be a hurdle for getting proper education.

> BRIEF ABOUT 'VIDYA SAHAYATA':

'Vidya Sahayata' a scholarship scheme is specially meant for the students who are pursuing Higher Education after Std 12th. Duration for the higher education will be either for 3 or 4 years depends upon the course opted by the student.

These students are from remote rural areas of Marathwada Region of Maharashtra State,

They are Needy and from financially weaker section who cannot afford the cost of further education (higher education) after Std **12th**.

The students are Scholars, ambitious and have keen desire to pursue higher education and become self-reliant.

Under the scheme 'Vidya Sahayata', the selected students will be provided Financial Aid in the form of 'Vidya Sahayata' for Rs. 25,000/- (twenty-five thousand) each year for their higher educational and other expenses during studies.

We all know that; **Education** is the only ladder for these rural children to climb out of poverty.

And hence, under this scheme, **CEF** creates bright future for **30 rural** students by providing them financial aid for 3- or 4-years duration of their higher education.

Students benefited by this scheme can then fully focus on their studies.

What's the Significance of 'Vidya Sahayta' Scheme in students' higher education?

This scheme will make a significant difference for a needy student pursuing higher education. Here are some ways:

1. **Cover tuition fees:** The financial aid will cover a significant portion of the student's tuition fees, making it easier for them to afford their education.

- 2. **Purchase books and study materials:** The student can use the financial aid to purchase books, study materials, and other necessary resources that can be expensive and difficult to afford for someone in need.

> Project Geographic Area:

To implement this project, **CEF** is targeting to cover **5 districts**, which are **Aurangabad**, Jalna, Beed, Hingoli, Parbhani.

Good educational facilities are not available in the above mentioned 5 districts and hence the students are away from the main stream of overall development. The main source of livelihood is farming by people either in their own field or those of others.

The literacy rate is not more than 72%.

Target Population:

CEF is targeting **30 Students** (Age between **16 - 18** years, preferably after Std 12th) of our project area.

These students are scholars and ambitious but cannot pursue higher education because of their weak financial conditions.

PROJECT DURATION: Three OR Four Years.

PROJECT UNIQUENESS: Concept of Super 30:

- **CEF** selects only **30 students** each year for this scheme.
- Excellent work requires favouring quality over quantity. When focus on **quality** over quantity, one achieves better results for life. This scheme is much accomplished because instead of focusing on numerical value, it focuses on student's holistic development in depth.
- With 30 number of youths every year for this project, we can achieve this aim.

> Methodology (Approach towards problem Solution):

A) Selection Process:

 CEF have data of schools and colleges of our rural area. We gather students' information details by placing requirement in various social media like News

- Paper, WhatsApp Groups, Facebook page, handouts, etc. for such students for the selection of Higher Education and receive the data.
- After receiving the data, CEF coordinators communicates with their respective school teachers and get required information details (like academic progress, financial background, etc) about students.
- **CEF** conducts **Aptitude Test** and students shortlisted on the basis of their performance in Aptitude Test, they have to undergo **Personal Interview**. **Parents Interview will also conduct** at the selected date and time.

B) Offering the aid:

- After satisfied by the all means of selection criteria, the students and their parents are called upon for the completion of required procedure and formalities to disburse the financial aid to them under Vidya Sahayata Scheme.
- Students will have to remain at their respected home and complete the education.

C) Students' response:

• The students also have to produce supporting documents of the expenses made by them.

> OUTCOMES:

The potential outcomes of 'Vidya Sahayata' for a needy student are include:

- Increased access to higher education: Financial aid will provide students with the financial resources they need to pay for tuition, books, and other expenses associated with higher education, which will increase their access to college or university.
